*Fujian before Reform, Part 4*; publication expected 2019

Part of an ongoing project that documents the scope of variation in local development experiences. This project is based upon new datasets assembled from county-level sources; it includes digital base maps, accurate to specific time periods, so that the data can be examined using a geographic information system.
